- Whole Tone:** A four-measure exercise starting on Gb, ascending and then descending the whole tone scale.
- Major Pentatonic, Minor Pentatonic, Blues Scale, Augmented Scale, Major Cell:** A five-measure exercise where each measure contains one of these scales or cells, starting on Gb.
- Minor, Dominant, Bebop, Half-Diminished, Altered:** A five-measure exercise where each measure contains one of these scales, starting on Gb.
